## **Biblical Wisdom: There are things that God wants Elderly People to do...**

This is why you are still alive; God has work for you... Let me tell you something the world won't say... You are not too old, you are too anointed to quit now, society says slow down... The world says step aside but God, He says rise up because your age is not a weakness, it's a weapon... Your grey hair is not a sign of decline, they're proof you've been through fire and survived and now you carry wisdom this generation desperately needs... God never puts people on a shelf, the devil does that... Culture does that but not the God of Abraham who called Moses at eighty... Who gave Sarah a child at 90, who used Anna the prophetess to proclaim the Messiah after decades of worship... If you're still breathing, you're still chosen... If your heart is still beating, God still got assignments with your name on them...

**Isaiah 46:4** - "Even to your old age and grey hairs I am He, I am He who will sustain you... I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you"...

But here is the danger, if you start believing the lie that your best days, years are behind you... You'll stop praying with power, you will stop walking in purpose... You will start living like your only goal is to survive, instead of impact... But God didn't bring you this far for you to coast to the end... He brought you this far, so that you could finish with fire... You're in a season of spiritual authority now, the kind that doesn't come from youth or energy... But from time in the trenches, from decades of battles, losses, victories and prayers that shook heaven... So, no, you're not done, you are just stepping into your most powerful season and there are 7 things God still wants you to do...

### **Number 1... Pass down your faith, don't just pass down possessions...**

Let me ask you something real, when your time on this earth ends... What will you leave behind, a house, a little money, a family recipe?... That's nice but God is looking for something eternal, because possessions wear out but faith echoes through generations ...

**Psalms 78:4** - "We will not hide them from their children but tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of God and His might and the wonders that He has done..."

So that they should set their hope in God, that's your call right now... Not just to leave an inheritance but to leave a spiritual foundation... Too many people pass down furniture but forget to pass down fire... You've got grandkids who need your testimony and you got sons and daughters who need to hear what God brought you through... Your story of survival may be the very thing that keeps them from quitting... Tell them about the nights when you prayed when there was no money left... Tell them about the times God healed your body, tell them about the tears, the miracles, the breakthroughs... Don't just let them see your bible, teach them how to use it and listen ... It is not too late, even if you didn't raise your kids in the faith... You still can plant seeds now, your repentance and your testimony carry weight... Write it down, speak it out, live it boldly... Don't let your legacy be locked in a bank vault, let it be written in the hearts of the next generations...

**Deuteronomy 6:6-7** - "These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road..."

You may not see the fruit of every seed you plant but God promises... The harvests will come, because when you pass down your faith, you don't just leave behind a memory... You leave behind a movement and that's the kind of inheritance heaven celebrates...

### **Number 2... Speak life, your words still have power...**

You may not move as fast as you used to... You may not lift what you once could... But let me tell you something that hasn't weakened with age: your words...

**Proverbs 18:21** - "The tongue has the power of life and death and those who love it will eat it's fruit"...

That verse doesn't expire when you turn sixty... Your voice still carries weight in the spiritual realm and if you're not careful, you'll use that power to curse what God wants to bless... You've seen a lot... You've lived through

hard seasons but pain, disappointment and fatigue can make you speak death without even realizing it... You say things like “nothing ever changes” “I’m just getting old” “this generation is lost”... But that’s not the voice of faith, that’s the voice of defeat and the devil loves it when older believers curse the future with their words...

Listen to me: you’ve earned the right to be heard... People lean in when you speak and that’s not the time to murmur - it’s time to prophesy... Start declaring what God says, not what fear says... Speak life over your health!... Speak blessings over your children!... Speak breakthrough over your church!... Speak revival over your community!... Don’t let your words reflect your aches, let them reflect your anointing... When Caleb was eighty-five years old, he said: “Give me this mountain”... He didn’t speak retirement, he spoke conquest...

**Joshua 14:12** – “Now give me this hill country that the God promised me that day”...

God honoured it... Don’t forget: your words aren’t just shaping your atmosphere... They’re shaping the mindset of those who come after you... Young people are listening!... Your grandkids are absorbing!... What they hear you say becomes what they believe is normal... So be the voice that builds, not the voice that breaks... Be the one who speaks with hope, not just hindsight... Be the one who declares healing, not just history... Be the one who says: “God is not finished with me or with this family”... Because when you speak life, you’re not just releasing sound - you’re releasing spiritual legacy...

**Number 3... Keep serving, retirement isn’t in the Bible...**

Let me say something that might surprise you: heaven doesn’t recognize retirement... You won’t find the word “retire” anywhere in scripture when it comes to your calling... The world tells you to slow down, take it easy and let young people handle it... Where did God say that?... Did He retire Abraham when his body got old?... No - He gave him a promise that outlived him...

**Genesis 17:5-6** - “I will make you exceedingly fruitful and I will make nations of you; kings shall come from you”...

Did He retire Moses at eighty?... No - He started his assignment...

**Exodus 7:7** - “Moses was eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three when they spoke to Pharaoh.”

Did He retire Anna the old widow in Luke 2?... No - she spent her final years worshipping, fasting and prophesying in the temple... God honoured her by letting her lay eyes on the Messiah... God doesn’t need your youth, He needs your yes... You may not run as fast but you can intercede harder than ever... You may not lead on stage but you can mentor someone behind the scenes... You may not preach a sermon but you can still speak truth to someone in pain...

There are lonely hearts in your church who need your comfort... There are single moms who need your wisdom... There are broken men who need your strength... Don’t you dare believe the lie that you’ve outlived your usefulness... The enemy wants you to think your season is over but God’s kingdom doesn’t have an expiration date for obedience...

**Romans 12:11** “Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord”...

That wasn’t written to young people, that was written to believers at every age... So instead of coasting to the finish line - sprint... Instead of taking it easy - take up your post in prayer, in service, in wisdom... Your hands may be wrinkled but they still heal... Your eyes may be dimmer but your vision is stronger... Your voice may be softer but your spirit is louder than ever... The Kingdom still needs you!... Your church still needs you!... God still calls you His servant - not His spectator... So rise up, because there is still Kingdom work with your name on it...

**Number 4... Forgive deeply, free your heart before you see Him face to face...**

You are not too old to forgive... In fact, forgiveness might be the most important thing God is calling you to do in this season of your life... Let’s be honest - if you’ve lived long enough, you’ve been hurt... By family... By friends... Maybe even by church folk... You’ve been lied to, left out, misunderstood, mistreated and with every wound,

something hardened in your heart... Maybe you forgave on the outside but deep down it still stings... Listen carefully: you cannot walk into eternity holding onto what Jesus died to free you from...

**Matthew 6:14** - "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you"...

That's not a suggestion, that's a warning... Unforgiveness doesn't just weigh down your heart - it poisons your soul and the older you get... The more dangerous it becomes, because bitterness grows silently... It buries itself beneath "I'm fine"... It hides under "That was years ago" but it's still there and it's blocking your peace... It's time to let it go, that person who hurt you - they may never apologize... That family member who betrayed you - they might never admit it... But you're not forgiving for their sake, you're forgiving for yours... So, you can breathe again... So, you can worship with no guilt, no bitterness, no hidden pain. So you can meet Jesus face to face with a clean heart.

You're not too old to heal, you're not too old to be set free... Don't carry old wounds into a new season... Don't let the past have more power than the cross... Don't let the last chapter of your life be filled with resentment when it could be filled with release...

**Ephesians 4:31-32** - "Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger... Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you"...

Choose peace... Choose freedom... Choose forgiveness - not just once but every time the enemy tries to remind you... Because you don't want to step into eternity carrying what God already buried...

**Number 5... Stay hungry for God, never settle for religion...** Let me ask you something that cuts deep: has your walk with God become routine? You still pray but only out of habit... You still read your Bible but not like you used to... You still go to church but deep inside you feel dry... That's not because you're old... That's because your hunger has faded and God is calling you to stir it back up...

**Psalms 92:12-14** - "The righteous will flourish like a palm tree... They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green"...

Did you catch that?... God doesn't want you dry, He wants you fresh... Not full of religion but full of fire... You see, as people age, many settle... They get comfortable with tradition, with routine... They stop expecting God to speak like He used to but listen: God hasn't stopped speaking, we've stopped listening... When was the last time you wept in worship?... When was the last time you sat still long enough to hear God whisper?... When was the last time the Word of God pierced you like it did when you first believed?...

Don't let age rob you of intimacy... You may not shout like you used to but you can still burn with holy fire... You may not fast for days but you can still sit with God for hours... You may not understand all the new songs but you can still worship with pure devotion... Let me tell you the truth: God isn't impressed by your church attendance... He is after your heart... He wants to be with you, not just your religious routine... So don't settle for memories of what God used to do... Press in, ask for more and pray like you just met Him... Worship like He's the only one in the room... Read the Word like your soul depends on it, because it does...

**Jeremiah 29:13** - "You will seek Me and find Me, when you shall search Me with all your heart"...

God still reveals... God still fills... God still speaks and if you stay hungry... He will meet you there, because even in old age, you can be full of fire...

**Number 6... Prepare for eternity, not just the funeral...** Let's get real for a moment, you've prepared your will... You've thought about the funeral and you've picked the photos... Maybe even the casket but have you prepared your soul?... Because one day, sooner than you think, you will stand face to face with the living God... When that moment comes, it won't matter how nice the service was... It won't matter who showed up, the only thing that will matter is - were you ready?...

**2 Corinthians 5:10** - “For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ... So that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad”...

All of us, not just murderers or atheists... Not just the rebellious or the proud... Every believer will stand before Jesus - not to determine salvation but to give an account for how we lived... Every idle word... Every hidden motive... Every wasted opportunity... Let that hit you... You don't just die... You transition into eternity and what you do now echoes forever... So let me ask you: are you living for earth or for heaven?... You can spend your final years collecting stuff - or collecting souls... You can spend time watching television - or watching for who needs prayer... You can waste your final breath gossiping - or use it to bless your family with bold faith...

God's not calling you to coast into heaven with your hands in your pockets... He's calling you to finish strong - with purpose in your eyes and eternity in your heart... That means making things right... That means staying alert... That means forgiving fully, loving deeply, obeying quickly... Stop saying “I'll do it later”... Later is a lie, the enemy uses to rob you of the now... You are in the final act of your story and how you live it will echo through all of eternity... Prepare your heart... Prepare your soul... Live with the judgment seat in mind - not fearfully but faithfully...

**Ecclesiastes 12:13-14** - “Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is the duty of all mankind... For God will bring every deed into judgment... Including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil”...

You don't need to fear standing before God - if you spend your life walking with Him...

**Number 7... Bless the younger generation, be a spiritual covering**... Let me tell you something powerful: You weren't just meant to grow old... You were meant to become a covering; a shield, a protector, a spiritual anchor for the generation behind you... Don't underestimate the power of your blessing... In Genesis 49, before Jacob died, he gathered his sons and spoke life over each one of them... He didn't leave them money, he left them prophetic direction...

**Genesis 49:28** - “All these are the twelve tribes of Israel and this is what their father said to them when he blessed them, giving each the blessing appropriate to him”...

That's what God is calling you to do in this season; to bless not just financially but spiritually... You've seen too much to stay silent... You've walked through too many fires not to speak up... This generation is searching for truth while drowning in lies and they don't need another trend or TikTok... They need someone like you; full of fire, wisdom and prayer... They need a voice that says: “I see greatness in you. I declare God's promises over your life... I break every generational curse in Jesus name”...

Your words are not just nice, they are nuclear in the spirit... So stop cursing the younger generation... Stop saying “kids these days” and start interceding... Pray for their purity and cover their calling... Protect them in the spirit like a warrior with a sword... Be the voice of heaven in a world that's shouting confusion... You may not understand their slang but you understand their need for God... You may not dress like them but you can still wrap them in your prayers...

They don't need you to be trendy... They need you to be truthful... Be the one who lays hands on them and says, “God's not done with you and you were born for more”... Be the one who tells them, “You're not too broken... You're not too far gone”... Be the one who reminds them there is power in the name of God... Because when you bless the next generation, you're not just sending them forward; you're securing your legacy in the Kingdom... You may be at the end of your race but your blessing can launch theirs... Heaven will remember the seed you sowed...

**Conclusion: You're not too old. You are right on time**... Let me look you in the eye and tell you something the devil's been trying to keep you from hearing: **You are not too old... You are right on time**...

The world may have stopped calling your phone and your job may have let you go... Your body may not be as strong but heaven hasn't changed it's mind about you... God is still calling your name... He's still writing your

story... He's still assigning you to people... He's still preparing crowns, rewards and eternal glory for everything you do in His name... You're not retired, you're refined and you are not slowing down... You are stepping into your spiritual prime...

Don't believe the lie that says your season has passed... As long as you have breath, you have purpose... As long as your heart beats, you have a calling... As long as you can speak, you have the power to shift someone's destiny with your words... Maybe you haven't done everything right... Maybe you feel like you wasted time but listen to me - God is not limited by your past... He is focused on your next step and your next step is this: **finish strong...**

Don't crawl across the finish line dragging regret and bitterness... Run like a warrior and worship like a champion... Walk in boldness, faith and fire... Speak truth... Bless generations... Forgive quickly... Love deeply... Pray fiercely and prepare to meet your Savior... Not with fear but with faith in your eyes and fire in your soul... This life was never about comfort, it was always about calling... So don't waste these final chapters, they could be your most powerful ever...

The Bible is full of people who were used after the world said they were finished... Moses led a nation out of slavery at 80 and Caleb claimed new territory at 85... Anna the prophetess fasted and worshipped into her old age and saw the Messiah with her own eyes... Paul wrote his final letters from prison - not in retirement and Jesus Himself finished His assignment in His final breaths...

So what makes you think God is done with you?... Let this be the season where your legacy is written in bold... Let this be the time you leave behind something more powerful than money; an unshakable faith... Let the younger generation see that growing old with God doesn't mean becoming irrelevant... It means becoming dangerous to the enemy, because you're not just aging... You're advancing... You are not just fading... You're flourishing...
